

RAPP NATURE CAMP

This will be the 34th season for this summertime day camp in Rappahannock County, Virginia. The goals of the camp are: to awaken an interest in our wonderfully beautiful and diverse natural surroundings, to observe living plants and animals in their natural habitats, to understand the role of human beings in this shared environment, and to have fun and make new discoveries every day. The camp's home base is on the upper Hazel River, two miles west of Route 231. Campers will explore the forests, meadows, rivers and ponds of the Singing Creek property and surrounding areas, including the Shenandoah National Park which is within walking distance. Our theme for study in 2019 will be "LANDSCAPES." We will study our landscapes scientifically and with an artistic eye, and come to appreciate their beauty as gardens, homesites and wilderness areas.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Activities are almost all outdoors and will include games and songs, hiking, identifying butterflies and moths, learning to recognize all kinds of snakes, assessing water quality, catching and releasing wild animals, caring for flowers and trees, and producing a camp newspaper. Note that all campers will be expected to participate in all activities, including writing, drawing and oral presentations, plus one night of camping. Be prepared to get wet and muddy! Camp days are Monday - Friday, 9:00am to 3:00pm. An overnight campout is planned during Session 1 on the night of Thursday, June 27.

PLEASE NOTE: This is a two-week educational program, and the campout and closing programs are important. In fairness to other prospective campers, please do not apply if you do not plan to attend EVERY DAY.

PERENNIAL CAMPERS

Rapp Nature Camp is happy once again to announce a series of nature education outings for adults – our "Perennial Campers!" We will have a special orientation meeting the afternoon of March 3, to be followed by six excursions to interesting habitats in Rappahannock and surrounding counties. Some of our topics for study and observation will be: tree identification, butterflies and dragonflies, migrating birds, and sky phenomena. Attendance at all events will be optional, and all Perennial Campers will be able to bring along a guest! Minimum age is 18, but guests may be any age if accompanied by an adult. TUITION AND REGISTRATION

Tuition for two weeks of camp is \$350 (Session 1 or Session 2). PARENTS: Please fill out a separate registration form for each camper and return it to Rapp Nature Camp, P.O. Box 145, Sperryville, VA 22740. Enclose a nonrefundable deposit of \$40 payable to "Rapp Nature Camp." You will receive a packet of information about camp, including directions to the camp site, what to bring each day, and request for health information. We accept campers on a first-come-first-served basis — early registration is encouraged! For insurance purposes and to ensure that we will have an accurate list of campers who will attend, we require that all health information and payment of full tuition be submitted promptly when requested.
